Cassandra

All Levels - 4 hrs. - finished size 9" I x 5" w x 7" h w/o handle - \$65

Thursday, March 13, 2025

This is a great basket for a doorknob or to hang by the outside door. The basket starts with a solid woven base so items will not fall out. We will then chase weave using 3/8" FF and ¼" spaced dyed FF reed. The front will pooch out to make a handy opening. There are space dyed overlays on every other spoke. The handle is turquoise dyed leather.

Bring usual basket tools including a **spoke weight**, packers, clips, scarfer, cutting board, scissors.



Simply Summer

High Intermediate to Advanced -8 hrs. finished size 10'' l x 6'' w x 8'' h. Handle adds 3.5'' - \$80

Thursday, March 13, 2025

This basket makes a nifty small tote or purse. Using a double slotted oak wooden base, we will first weave a simple inner basket of turquoise dyed 3/8 FF reed. This becomes our mold for the outer basket. Two colors of stakes will be inserted on the outside and the basket is continuous woven with 4 mm Hamburg cane. An oak handle will be inserted at the top. Twill experience is a must.

Bring usual basket tools including angle cutters.

Friday, March 14, 2025

(Select Blue or Brown on your registration form) Advanced Beginners and Up – 6 hrs. – finished size 10" I x 8" w x 12" h including handle - \$60

This basket makes a fabulous tote or catchall. The basket starts with a solid woven base so items will not fall out. Three rows of 3/8" FF reed get it upright. The sides are chase woven with a continuous weave. The corners are not creased, creating pouched out sides. The top is finished with 3 rod-wale. Before lashing with cane, the reed handle will be wrapped it a pretty cane design. Choose from blue or brown.



Bring usual basket tools including a **spoke weight**, packers, clips, scarfer, cutting board, scissors.

Penelope

Friday, March 14, 2025 Advanced – 8 hrs. – finished size – 13" wide x 2" high - \$75
This beautiful tray is woven in natural and three Aegean inspired colors of dyed round reed. A number of techniques will be taught or reviewed, such as inserting additional spokes, twining to have stacking colors or swirling colors, 3 and 4-rod wale with a step-up,



and 5-rod wale. Students must know 3-rod wale with a step-up. Slower weavers may need to finish after class.

Usual basket tools including **2 SPOKE WEIGHTS, NEEDLE NOSE PLIERS**, scissors, angle cutters, spray bottle, towel, clips, packers, tape measure, awl, and any other tools you find useful.

Counterpoint

Saturday, March 15, 2025 Advanced - 8 hrs. - finished size 8.5" w x 9" h - \$80

This is striking pattern packs a big wow. Using a double slotted oak wooden base, we will first weave a simple inner basket of 3/8 FF reed. This becomes our mold for the outer basket. Dyed stakes will be inserted on the outside and the basket is continuous woven with 4 mm Hamburg cane. Twill experience is a must.

Bring usual basket tools including angle cutters, small and larger packing tools, towel, clips, & spray bottle.

Storage Savvy

This handy storage basket will find lots of uses in your home. It may be woven in ½" flat reed or in ¼" flat oval reed in over/under weave or, for more advanced students, in ¼" flat oval with a twill. It features overlays on the side spokes, and a decorative band. Emphasis will be on shaping the basket.

Choose ½" FF or ¼" FO reed.
Overlays & accents will be brown.
